Background-I



League of Arab States

- -The Arab States Broadcasters have enjoyed monopoly up to the early 2000.
- -FM Radio deployment started slowly, picked up momentum mid 90's.
- -Broadcasters and Audience have enjoyed the availability of FM Band receivers without any single effort at low cost as well as low power consumption.







- FM quality Radio was appreciated by the Audience in the presence of Highly congested limited AM BW.

-Satellite TV spread was a gateway for Arabs free access to information as well as entertainment.



Current situation



- -De-regulation has started in the Arab Countries at a various rates.
- -National Coverage is not a major request for all commercial broadcasters.
- The FM Spectrum is relatively congested in most Arab Countries.
- -Digital Audio will provide better quality and will be appreciated by the listeners



Current situation



- -VHF Band III was planned for T-DAB in the RRC-06....However further effort is needed in this field L- band usage is not envisaged in our Area.
- -Receivers prices are encouraging to start new services, however international broadcasters teaming to join the New digital ERA will encourage manufacturers to thin their profits.



Future Tasks



- -ASBU to adopt Digital Audio Broadcasting (T-DAB+).
- ASBU Working groups shall prepare the necessary information for the whole broadcast chain.
- ASBU shall seek the support of the high level official as part of the Arab League



Future Tasks



- OMAN Pilot DAB+.
- Available T-DAB Channels are 10 & 11
- Site Characteristics. & Coverage TBD
- Receivers Distribution Plan for successful Trial.

- The DAB is a proven Technology and ready to be implemented in our region
- The DAB Receivers prices will be decisive factor in the implementation.
- The Launch of DAB Pilot projects in a number of Arab Capitals will play a major factor in spreading the Technology.
- ASBU is ready to spread awareness among members to convey the DAB specifications to the local regulators

 - Expertise and related information to the Arab Broadcasters.
 - Equipments to run Pilot projects at various simultaneous Arab Capitals. To create Momentum
- -Arab Broadcasters are encouraged to approach the respective regulators to provide incentives for both public and private broadcasters.
- Network operators shall be subsidized by the government for a definite period e.g. till the receivers population reach 20%.
